## **1. Introduction**

WISETRIP is an innovative mobility service platform, which provides personalized multi-modal trip information sourced from connected variant journey planners, acting as active sub-systems of a 'global' journey planner system. The system is accessible by travelers through various mobile or fixed terminals/devices before and during the journey.

WISETRIP web interface is currently available for pilot operation under [www.wisetrip.travel](http://www.wisetrip.travel). The pilot system is able to get requests and provide multimodal trip answers, for a limited number of routes within Greece, Finland, UK, Italy and China.

The aim of this document is to provide a short overview of the participating Journey Planners presenting their geographical coverage and supported transportation means.

## 2. Origin / Destinations covered by WISETRIP

Three interurban and two urban Journey Planning Systems are currently in cooperation with the WISETRIP Project willing to become active sub-systems of the "global" journey planner system that is implemented. Participating Journey Planners cover routes within Greece, Finland, UK, Italy and China

The rest of this section presents information about the routes supported in each one of the five countries mentioned above.

International routes are supported by **FORTHcrs Airline Interface**, an application powered by the Global Distribution Service (GDS) provider Sabre Travel Network. The system gives access to the schedules of more than 400 airlines worldwide for a period of at least 180 days (and up to 331 days).

### 2.1. Greece – Interurban Journey Planning

Includes the following public transport services:

- Athens Metropolitan area ( Metro, tram, bus, trolley-bus, coaches)
- Greek ferry schedules (more than 100 ports, e.g. Piraeus, Rafina, Heraklion, Patra, Mykonos, Santorini, Skopelos, Rodos, Thessaloniki, Corfu, Argostoli, Kyllini, Kos, Milos, Ydra, Sami, Paros, Kythira, etc.)
- Domestic Greek flights via Athens Airport (connections with more than 30 airports, e.g. El. Venizelos Athens International Airport, Heraklion, Thessaloniki, Mykonos, Santorini, etc.)

### 2.2. Finland - Interurban Journey Planning

Provides information on rail and long distance bus (coach) connections in Finland and connecting ferries of the Finnish archipelago and local transport connections for 21 cities.

The service includes bus, train and local traffic schedules and available route alternatives for the following regions and operators:

- The Greater Helsinki area: Helsinki, Espoo, Kauniainen,
- Vantaa, Kerava, Kirkkonummi
- The cities of Turku and Oulu with their surrounding areas
- Tampere, Joensuu, Kotka, Lappeenranta, Mikkeli, Jyväskylä, Lahti, Kuopio, Hyvinkää, Hämeenlinna, Imatra, Pori, Seinäjoki, Varkaus
- Trains operated by VR (Finnish Railways)
- Coaches

### 2.3. UK – North East England Interurban Journey Planning

Includes public transport services in North East England and Cumbria - by bus, train, Metro and ferry - plus national rail and coach networks in the United Kingdom.
